The Mobile Training Laboratories

Training is critical, but increasingly challenging

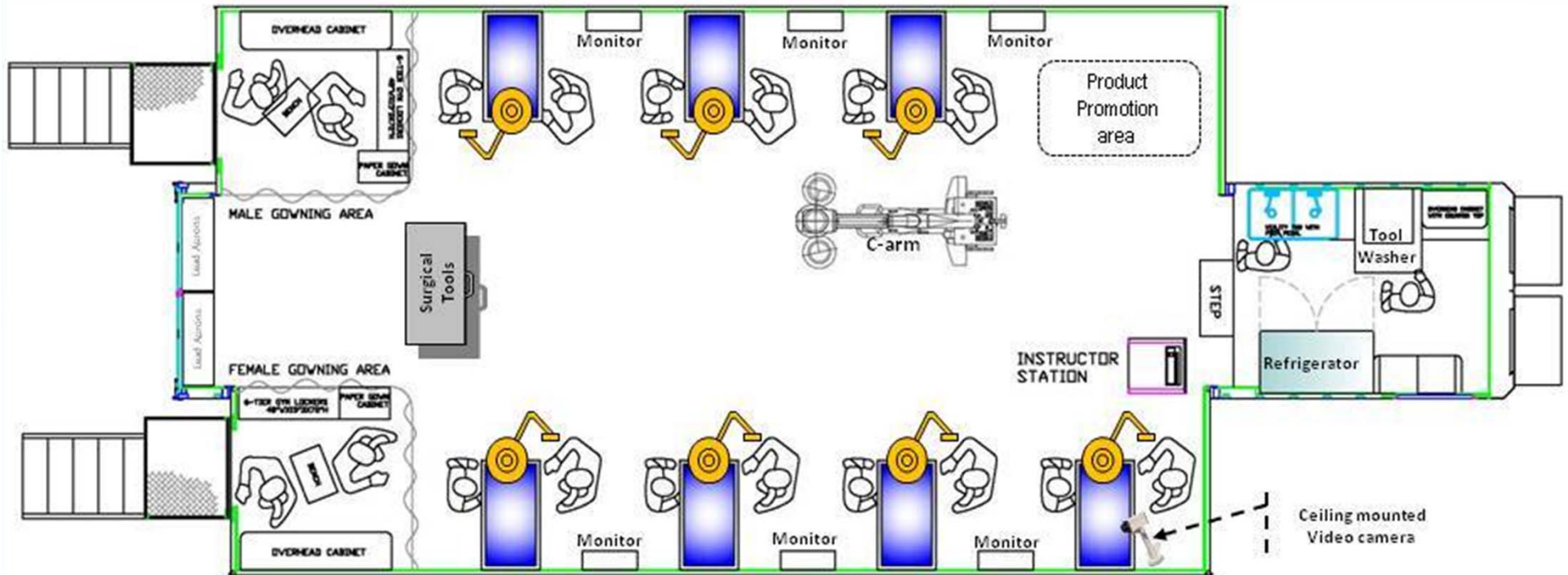
- Medical healthcare professionals find it difficult to take training time away from their family, practice and patient commitments, with each day away having a significant negative financial impact.
 - Example: Orthopedic surgeons work a median of 60 hours a week, with a median of 103 patient visits per week, according to AAOS
- Physician travel cost is escalating due to rising airfare, luxury hotel accommodations, rental cars or limousine service, meals, entertainment and per diem
 - >\$1,250/attendee/event
 - Last minute cancelation rate as high as 50%
- Maintaining a dedicated corporate training facility is expensive, and geographically limiting.
- Fixed location training events require challenging scheduling and logistics subject to disruptions caused by last minute Physician cancelations, Airline delays/cancellations, and inclement Weather disruptions
- Eliminate the perception of influencing medical decisions with “training junkets” eliminating potential physician or industry conflict of interest and assuring compliance with the AdvaMed code of ethics

Mobile bio-skills laboratories

The Surgical Training Institute (STI) laboratories are completely self-contained 53 ft. semi-trailer with expandable walls that slide-out to provide 1,000 sq.ft. of bio-skills laboratory space

Fully equipped: laboratories includes up to 8 cadaveric stations, gowning rooms, C-arm, integrated audio and visual capabilities, HDTV monitors for instructor presentation, surgical supplies, tool washing/decontamination

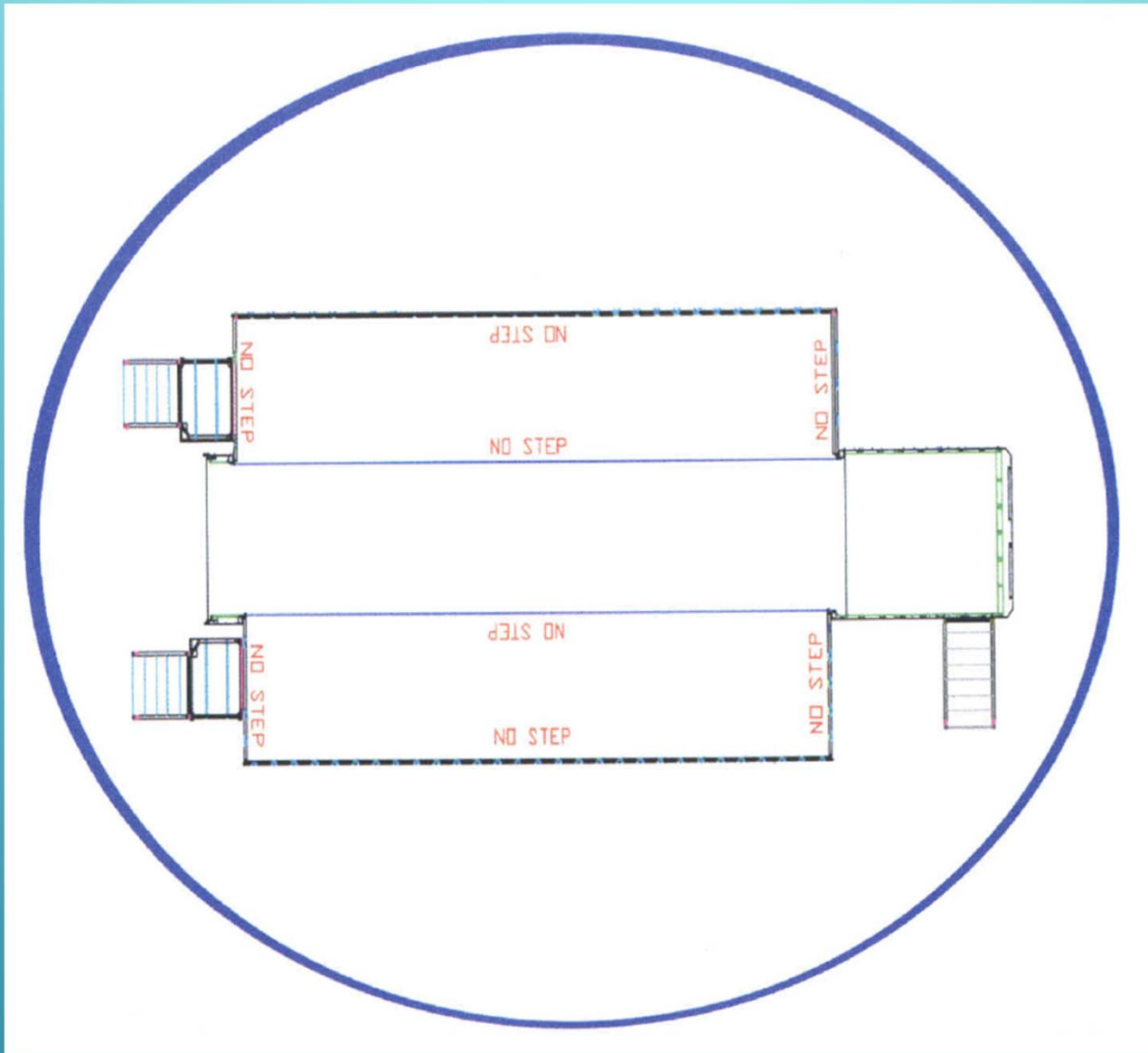


Training applications

Unique issue to consider with Mobile

- Limited storage on board
- Equipment limitations, predefined requirements
- Requires Client collaboration and coordination
- Staffing logistics
- Transportation weight restriction
- Limited tissue storage
- Limited clean water/waste water capacity
- Limited number of stations
- Large, level surface area parking
- Multi state X-ray registration
- Biohazard waste disposal
- No conference room, no bathrooms
